Short Term Objective Sub-Committee #1: a) Enhanced First Call for Help's electronic accessibility through purchase of software for online database (installation in process); b) Gathered resource information from First Call for Help in each focus area for the Community Resource Card that was developed.</p> <p>2. Short Term Objective Sub-Committee #2: a) Implemented a Bi-Lingual Community Awareness Survey which was distributed at the Salvation Army's Back to School Fair in August, 2005. 185 surveys completed in English and 1 in Spanish; b) Distributed 2500 Resource Cards to survey respondents and others through the assistance of Volunteer Agencies and Cape Public Schools; c) Analyzed the results of the completed Community Awareness Surveys with results ready to be shared.</p> <p>3. Short Term Objective Sub-Committee #3: a) Identified six Family Development Programs that will be monitored (per the plan) during 2005-06. The programs are Building Strong Families, Al's Pals, Grandparent Support Group, Parenting Skills Inventory, Parenting Basics (LFCS) and MMP Parenting Program.</p> <p>4.</p>

Decision made to not publish a written Family Resource Guide, but instead focus on the promotion of First Call For Help online.</p> <p>3. Position and funding secured for FY2006 to sustain the position of Community Case Manager; Subcommittees of the Assessment Committee (of which Parent and Community Education is a member) have all established chairpersons, membership and meeting dates.</p> <p>4.</p>
