<p>Briefly list strategies completed.</p> <p>1. Screenings: baseline in 2004-05 was 6 school districts, 1632 children screened with 180 referrals (13.3% received treatment); in 2005-06 school year 6 districts, 2593 screenings with 325 referrals; still trying to determine the number of referrals receiving treatment. Goal was to screen 2040.</p> <p>2. Baseline set for daycare screenings: 331 children in 10 day cares received screenings with 33 referrals; no means of follow-up.</p> <p>3.</p> <p>4.</p>	
<p>List other accomplishments toward plan progress.</p> <p>1. Working on completing and distributing the oral health education pamphlets for women of child bearing age.</p> <p>2. Application has been made to the Missouri Foundation for a Priority Grant to increase dental sealant applications through school-based programs. There is a parent oral health education component included in the plan. We should hear by mid-May if we are recipients.</p> <p>3. Fluoride Varnish: (a partnership with MO Oral health program) 9 providers received training for application.</p> <p>4. In Feb. 87 Delta school children in grades K -3 received Fluoride Varnish application.</p>	
<p>List concerns/barriers to progress.</p> <p>Finding dental care for the referred treatment, especially orthodontic referrals. Cross Trails will be called upon as a first resource for restorative care.</p>
